

I Live My Faith Program Overview



The I Live My Faith program is designed to help Catholic Girl Scouts and Camp Fire Girls learn more about their faith and how to live it out. Girls will reflect on what we believe as Catholics, how we celebrate those beliefs through sacraments and how prayer fits into our daily life.

Program Objectives

The program is designed around the theme of Beliefs, Sacraments, Catholic Christian Living and Prayer. Each of these is divided into sections:

- Discover
- Connect
- Learn
- Pray

Eligibility

This program is designed for scouts ages 9-11, in Grades 4-6.

Process to earn the I Live My Faith Emblem

- The first step for earning I Live My Faith emblem is a commitment on the part of the scout and the scout's family. This emblem requires an adult to supervise the work.
- Order workbook from the Office for Evangelization of Youth and Young Adults at scouting@richmonddiocese.org or 804-622-5159 and submit workbook fee.
- Scout begins work on the award under the supervision of an Adult Advisor, Family Member, or Scout Leader. Adult/Advisor instructions can be found on pages 33-36 of the workbook.
- A separate journal is required for some of the activities.
- This is a girl led program. The girls will choose which activities they would like to complete through this faith journey.
- Upon completion, the girl, parent/guardian and advisor sign the Application for I Live My Faith Religious Medal Program.
- Remove the completed Application page from the booklet. Make a copy for your records.
- Forward the completed Application, Order Form and payment for the religious emblem to:

- The presentation of the emblem is done at the parish. Scouts are also encouraged to attend the Annual Diocesan Scout Mass where they will be recognized. It is recommended to have all paperwork submitted to the Diocese a month prior to ensure acknowledgement of the award at the Mass.
